Bookings and Cancellations

All bookings **MUST** be received by **Friday 20th June 2025**. If a booking is made after **Friday 20th June** a late booking fee of \$5.00 per booking will be added to your fees to cover additional administration related to the last-minute movement of staff and the on costs involved in managing the impact on all 3rd party suppliers.

All children must be enrolled with Kids United OSHC prior to booking. 7 days' notice is required for cancellation of a Vacation Care booking to ensure you will not incur out of pocket costs.

What to bring:

Please bring morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and a refillable drink bottle. If bringing food please make sure it's nutritious and doesn't require heating or cooking. Please remember that we are an allergy aware centre.

Your child will also need to wear covered or enclosed shoes, sun smart clothing (no straps) and bring a hat.

Please pack spare clothes in case of accident or messy play, and sunscreen if your child is sensitive to the centre's sunscreen.

Excursions:

All excursions are compulsory if your child is booked in on that day. Please arrive no later than 8:45am unless otherwise specified, as we have a strict departure time. Your child will be provided with a Kids United OSHC hat and a centre wrist band which must be worn on all excursions. Each child must have written consent from a parent/guardian to attend excursions.

Allergy/Asthma/Anaphylaxis

If your child/ren is anaphylactic or has an allergy which requires them to carry medications, a full kit must be supplied to Kids United OSHC. Action plans must be supplied for any asthma/anaphylaxis or allergies. Other medications can only be administered by staff if a medication form is completed, and the medication has the child's full name labelled.

Child Care Subsidy

Our services are registered with Centrelink, so you will be able to claim Child Care Subsidy on your fees.

Terms and Conditions Specific to Vacation Care

- All terms and conditions set out in the enrolment form apply in addition to the specific terms and conditions set out in this section (Terms and Conditions Specific to Vacation Care).
- I understand that Services are subject to cancellation or alteration on short-notice in the event of unsuitable weather conditions or other factors which may arise that are beyond Kids United's control. In the event a Service is cancelled, Kids United will notify me by phone and/or email as soon as possible should this become known. A full refund of any fees paid for the cancelled Services will be made. I understand that Kids United will not be liable to make any other additional payment to me in this event.
- I give permission for the child to leave the school premises to participate in external activities as indicated in the Service program.
- All bookings MUST be received by **Friday 20th June 2025**. If a booking is made after this date, a late booking fee of \$5.00 per booking will be added to your fees to cover additional administration related to the last minute movement of staff and the on costs involved in managing the impact on all 3rd party suppliers.
- Bookings may be cancelled at any time by giving 7 days advance notice to Kids United. Bookings cancelled on less than 7 days' notice, will be charged the full fee. The reason for this is that during Vacation Care programs Kids United is required to pay substantial deposits and guarantees to our 3rd party suppliers and Kids United has invested in the resources and staffing to manage these sessions well in advance of 7 days.
- Children with additional needs must be booked into a Service more than 4 weeks in advance to ensure funding and additional staffing needs can be met. Children with additional needs not booked within the relevant time period may not be able to use the nominated Service.
- Excursions are external outing that involves a number of external risk/factors that may be out of our control. These risk/factors are heightened where a student's behaviour may increase risk to self and others when on an excursion. As such, students who are on a current behaviour management plan will only be able to attend excursions if a meeting has been arranged with the families prior to the excursion. During the meeting, a suitable excursion behaviour plan will be devised and the approach to be followed identified. Both the parent and the student will be informed of the decision of attendance prior to the excursion.
